This vehicle is used only for the transportation of ill, injured, or orphaned fawns entrusted to our care. Fawns will be arriving soon and we must be ready. Reliable, safe transportation is essential.

Matt, our coordinator, puts many miles per week on this rescue vehicle. Calls may require driving back into rural hills, across creeks and heavily forested areas. Therefore, gas economy must be a large consideration in our choice of another truck that will service our needs for many years to come.

We are asking our friends of the fawns to help us locate a used vehicle to replace the one we now drive. We must find a four-cylinder truck with two-wheel drive, power steering, automatic shift, low mileage, heat and air, space behind the passenger seat for storage and extra seating.
